

2. What Our Class Is For

School should be a place where students can study with fun and get lots of knowledge and things they need in their social lives. Living life with fulfillment makes their mind and body better and healthier.

However, students who speak languages other than Japanese as their mother tongues are sometimes having a hard time understanding and talking in Japanese in their school life.

Our class supports them so that they can learn Japanese smoothly to enjoy their school lives in Japan. The other goal for us is to support the students to learn Japanese to enter high schools in Japan.

3. Who Our Class Is For

Our Japanese class is for students who are related to foreign countries, enrolled in public schools in Minato City, and feeling difficulties in understanding Japanese in their daily lives. Parents, the principal of their enrolling school, and the principal of our school discuss it before lessons start.

4. Aims of Our Class

- (1) To enhance students' positive attitude to study Japanese and communicate in it.
- (2) To enhance students' positive attitude to respect the culture of their countries and also accept Japanese culture.



5. Outline of Our Japanese Lessons

- (I) The number of lessons will be decided in a conference among the student, the homeroom teacher of his/her enrolling school, and the teacher of the Japanese class with consideration of his/her Japanese ability. We consider the schedule of his/her enrolling class as much as we can.
- (2) We teach Japanese as an additional language.
 - ① To develop skills to talk in Japanese in their daily lives.
 - ② To develop skills to study school subjects, read, and express themselves in Japanese.
 - 3 To develop skills of listening, speaking, reading, and writing in a good balance.
- (3) We support the students' daily lives.
 - (1) We support their school lives.
 - 2 We support their social lives.
 - We offer learning contents and materials that are suitable for each student. The lessons will be held in small groups.

6. Visiting and Application

Visiting our class and consultation is available at any time.

[Procedure to Join Our Class]

① Parent talks to the homeroom teacher and the principal of the school which the student is enrolled at about joining our class.

② The principal of the school which the student is enrolled in assesses the properness of the student's necessity to the Japanese class. The principal fills out an application form for our class and send it to the principal of Roppongi J.H.S. (The application is needed only at joining our class.)

③ The student and his/her parent come to Roppongi J.H.S. and have a conference with the principal and the teacher of the Japanese class.

4 We discuss and decide what days and periods the student comes to our class with the homeroom teacher of the enrolling school.

⑤ After all the procedure is done, the student starts commuting.

* Basically, the students can study in our class for up to 2 years

after he/she starts attending our class.
